If you would possibly be interested in acting as host family for part/whole of the experience please contact Sonia at school for further details.







#### Cooking Program

This term our Junior grades have had fun baking Chocolate Weetbix Slice in cooking. Many students has asked for a copy of the recipe so they can bake it at home for their families.

#### Gluten Free, Dairy Free Weetbix Slice

- 4 Gluten Free Weetbix
- 1 cup desiccated coconut
- 1 cup Gluten Free SR Flour
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 2 Tablespoons cocoa
- approx125g (1/2 cup) melted nuttelex
- 1 teaspoon vanilla essence



Mix in all other dry ingredients.

Pour metted margarine over the dry ingredients, add vanilla essence.

Mix until all mixture is wet and holds its shape when pressed.

Press mixture into slice tin using the back of a spoon to press down smooth.

Bake at 180 degrees for 15 minutes.

Sit on a cooling tray and ice when cool.

#### lcing

- 1 1/2 cups pure icing sugar
- 1 Tablespoon cocoa
- 2-3 Tablespoons hot water

Mix icing sugar and cocoa together.

Add hot water and mix well.

Pour over slice while still hot. Use the back of a spoon to carefully spread icing to all edges.

Cool in refrigerator before slicing.
















# Candolences


